North Island Championships

Tournament is held annually, on a rotational basis by each of the North Island Districts: Auckland, Wellington, and Eastern Central Bay of Plenty.

The age classes for this tournament are U18 to Masters.

The bow types are Recurve, Compound and Barebow. Longbow is accepted but there are no trophies currently for Longbow or Barebow for this tournament.

There are FOUR trophies to be awarded. They are awarded to the highest scoring archer on the Ranking round day across all age classes.

North Island Youth Championships

Tournament is held annually, on a rotational basis by each of the North Island Districts: Auckland, Wellington, and Eastern Central Bay of Plenty (staggered one after the Seniors).

The age classes for this tournament are U11 to U21 only.

The bow types are Recurve, Compound and Barebow. Longbow is accepted also.

There are no trophies for each division. Medals are awarded based on highest scorer in each division during the ranking round, and the top 3 in each match-play division.

The main trophy is the Hutton's Team Trophy. Donated by Alison and Royle Hutton in 2000, the trophy is awarded in the following fashion:

All archers entering the tournament have their names put into a hat and are randomly matched into pairs at the start of the tournament.

At the end of the ranking round, the random pair with the highest combined score wins the trophy and share it for the next calendar year.
