Appendix B: Minimum Qualifying Scores and Criteria of 2026 World Archery Field Events.

This policy sets out the process and criteria for the selection of athletes to represent Archery New Zealand at the 2026 World Archery Field Championships. The policy ensures that selections are transparent, consistent, and aligned with Archery New Zealand's High Performance strategy.

MQS:

MQS are determined based on the results of the **16th ranked archers** from the last four World Archery Field events. This ensures that the required standards reflect performances competitive enough to rank within the top 16 qualifiers internationally.

Reviewed and recommended by archers and officials with field archery experience.

* If the competition includes U21, otherwise only Open classes will be selected.

Requirements:

1. A minimum of two qualifying scores, achieved from any combination of marked and unmarked rounds.
- 2: Scores must include results from NZ Field Nationals 2026 and one other WA Field tournament, whether that is in NZ or Internationally.
3. While preference is given to MQS being achieved at different events and/or on different fields, this will not be an overriding requirement.

Eligibility:

Eligibility is as outlined in the Archery New Zealand Selection Policy.

Archers must review the selection policy and refer to the Archery NZ International Calendar for entry deadlines and the selection period.

An Expression of Interest (EOI) must be submitted before the event entry close off date. We encourage early completion of the EOI so we can share information directly with archers as information comes to hand.

Contingency Plan:

If the NZ Outdoor Field Nationals cannot be completed (e.g. due to adverse weather conditions), scores from other WA or IFFA field events may be considered.
